

CONSTITUTION

ALLEGHENY REGION MINISTERIAL FELLOWSHIP CHURCHES OF GOD, GENERAL CONFERENCE

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of this organization shall be: "The Allegheny Region Ministerial Fellowship."

ARTICLE II - PURPOSE

The purpose of this organization shall be to promote the best interest of the Churches of God, General Conference, in general, and the Allegheny Region Conference in particular. It shall endeavor to promote closer fellowship among its members, and to build up the spiritual atmosphere of our churches and their members, and to use its officers to assist the ministry by holding conferences, seminars and other aids for the benefit of its members, and those that they serve.

ARTICLE III - MEMBERSHIP

All ordained and licensed ministers are members after they have been received by the Allegheny Region Conference. Lay ministerial supply pastors shall be recognized as associate members of the organization.

ARTICLE IV - MEETINGS

This organization shall meet at the Spring and Fall CGWM rallies. Special meetings may be called by the President at his discretion after conferring with the other officers.

ARTICLE V - OFFICERS

The officers shall be elected at the spring meeting, at which time the following officers shall be elected for one year: President, Vice President, and Secretary. Whenever possible, the Vice President shall be elevated to the office of Presidency. In all cases, a majority vote will be necessary to elect. The officers shall be permitted to succeed themselves in office except the President who shall be eligible to serve but one year.

ARTICLE VI - AMENDMENTS

This Constitution may be amended at any regular meeting of the organization by a two third vote of the members present, providing such amendment shall have been submitted at a previous regular meeting.
